

ORDINANCE NO. 2003-3

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BOROUGH CODE OF
NORTHUMBERLAND BOROUGH, NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, TO PERMIT RIGHT HAND TURNS ONLY FROM QUEEN
STREET ONTO WATER STREET (SR 0011)**

WHEREAS, as a result of a traffic study performed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, the Borough Council has determined that the safety and well being of the general public will be promoted by permitting right hand turns only from Queen Street onto Water Street (SR 0011); and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council also believes that such action will help prevent traffic accidents, which have occurred at the aforesaid intersection in the past;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Northumberland County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Authority of the same as follows:

Section One: Right hand turns only shall be permitted at the intersection of Queen Street and Water Streets (SR 0011).

Section Two: The appropriate signs shall be erected in compliance with the relevant PENDOT regulations to permit right hand turns only at the intersection of Queen and Water Streets (SR 0011).

Section Three: Any person who violates this Ordinance commits a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, pay a fine as set forth in the Borough Schedule of Fees and Fines as set forth in the Borough Code.

Section Four: This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days following its adoption by Borough Council.

Section Five: Any Ordinance contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.
